MATERIAL	YES	NO
PAPERS / CARDBOARD Newspapers / Magazines Envelopes / Junk Mail / Catalogs Cardboard "If you can rip it, you can recycle it"	* Keep clean and dry * Flatten Cardboard Boxes	* DO NOT PUT IN BAGS
GLOSSY MAGAZINES Magazines with glossy covers and pages	* Keep clean and dry	* DO NOT PUT IN BAGS
METALS Aluminum, steel (tin) and bimetal food and beverage containers	* Empty and rinse * May be flatten	* No aerosol spray cans, paint cans, foil, pie pans, TV dinner trays * DO NOT PUT IN BAGS
GLASS BOTTLES & JARS Clear, brown and green glass food and beverage containers	* Empty and rinse * DO NOT BREAK * Labels may remain	* No ceramics, mirrors, crystal, milk glass, dishes, light bulbs, TV tubes, window and auto glass, Pyrex cookware * DO NOT PUT IN BAGS
PLASTIC Plastic #1 - #7 in the recycling symbol on the bottom	* Empty and rinse * May be flatten	* No motor oil or antifreeze, pesticide & chemical containers. * DO NOT PUT IN BAGS

DO NOT PLACE PLASTIC BAGS INTO RECYCLING - FOR THEY GET STUCK IN THE GEARS ON THE RECYCLING LINE SHUTTING THEM DOWN FOR HOURS TO GET THEM REMOVED.

Recycling curbside pickup is monthly and is collected the **first full week** of each month that starts with Sunday and is collected on Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday depending on your area.
